On average, 115 people are added to the nation's organ transplant waiting list each day --- one every 13 minutes. In addition, approximately 17 patients die every day while awaiting organ--one person every 85 minutes. Over 6,000 individuals died last year while on the U.S. organ transplant waiting list because the organ they needed was not donated in time.

The TIGER Give-Away Program Giving needy liver transplant patients a stuffed tiger pet for support. Transplantation can be a very lonely experience. Threats to the immune system limit many activities. Stuffed animals can help bridge the loneliness..

Family Aid Program Direct financial assistance to needy transplant families with the purchase of necessary equipment, supplies and medicines. Coordinated with regional Organ Procurement Organizations.

Web Page Support Program A free service to liver transplant support groups. We strongly believe in the power of networking information. The services are available to any non-profit organization supporting liver transplant families.

Scholarship Program Direct financial aid to donor and recipient families in need of educational assistance. The Justina Gilbert Memorial Scholarship coordinates efforts with TRIO (Transplant Recipients International Organization).
