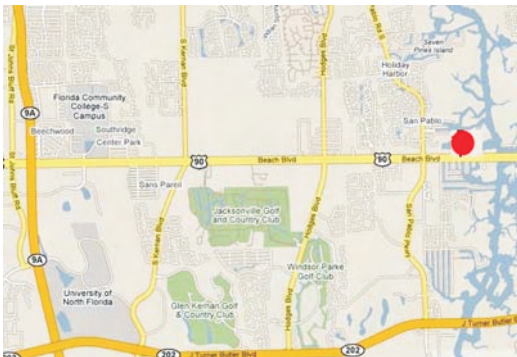

Community Outreach

Palm Cove Marina is a registered Clean Marina in Florida, and is proud to take the lead in clean water education.

The program includes instruction about boating safety and teamwork, waterway history and environmental respect. Some trips will include a fishing experience.

- Instruction by the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary about wearing a life vest and boating safety.
- Participation by local powerboat and sailing associations help the event.
- Each child boater is given Treasure Hunt questions about boating and the local waterway to answer on the boat trip.



- Waterfront hazards and fire safety demonstrations are highlighted.



Florida kids with special needs rarely have the chance to enjoy the pleasure of boating, fishing from a boat, or the excitement of the local waterways.

Our Marina Day Kids program is planning to change that circumstance.

Children from sponsored agencies will be treated to a very special boat ride.



Where the money goes?

All benefiting agencies and programs are properly registered as 501(c)(3) non-profit organizations with the Internal Revenue Service. Each fund raiser will spend less than 10% of the proceeds from the event on organizational or administration costs. All monies dispersed to affiliated agencies are designated to programs which reflect the same or better expense ratio. In other words --- This event is run by volunteers. 90-100% of the money collected will go directly to needy families.

Sponsorship Levels

Sponsored kids receive a boat trip, lunch after the trip, kids "nautical bag" and prize drawing tickets. Once the boat trip limit is reached, all funds are directed to the benefiting programs. Public attendance includes lunch and a prize drawing ticket. Sponsors will be noted with banners on individual boats and at the event area.



Children (ages 6-16) from sponsored agencies will be treated to the special boat ride. The trip is limited to 80 (and one adult for every 4 kids).
